## ELECTRONIC SUBMISSIONS TO THE AMERICAN INDIAN CULTURE AND RESEARCH JOURNAL

The *American Indian Culture and Research Journal* is now open access and published three times per year. All article and commentary submissions are peer-reviewed in a double-blind process.

### Submission Procedures for Articles, Commentaries, and Book Reviews

- ✿ Go to <https://escholarship.org/uc/aicrj>
- ✿ Click “Submit” in the upper right corner of the web page
- ✿ Sign in or create an account
- ✿ Follow the online prompts

### Article & Commentary Guidelines

- ✿ Include cover page indicating:
  - whether the manuscript is an essay or commentary
  - the manuscript’s scholarly significance
  - the word count (maximum 10,000), including notes and works cited
  - that the manuscript has not been previously published and is not under review elsewhere
  - that the author(s) is (are) the sole copyright owner(s) of the manuscript
- ✿ Include bio of two to three sentences
- ✿ Include 100-word abstract
- ✿ Adhere to 10,000-word maximum, including notes
- ✿ Follow Chicago Manual of Style format
- ✿ Auto-number endnotes
- ✿ Ensure that URL links in endnotes are active
- ✿ Secure permissions for images

### Book Review Guidelines

- ✿ 1,100 words maximum
