The cost to publish an article depends not only on its length, but also on its complexity, the number of images, etc. Minimal ballpark figures are the following:

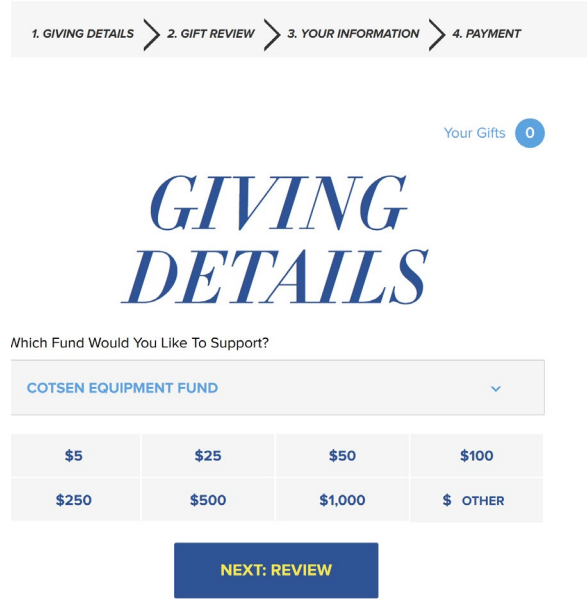
Short article (ca. 5 pages)	\$ 500
Medium length article (ca. 10 pages)	\$ 800
Long or complex article (ca. 20 pages)	\$ 1200

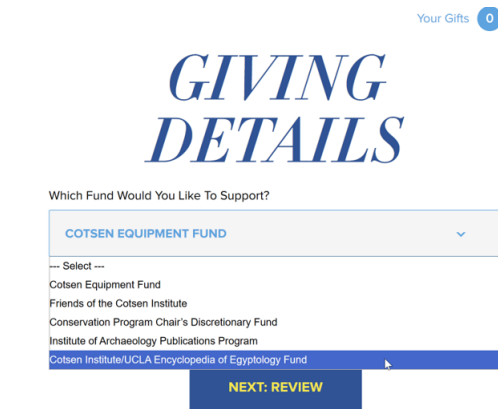

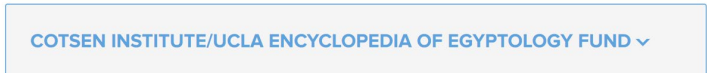
You will get the following screen:
