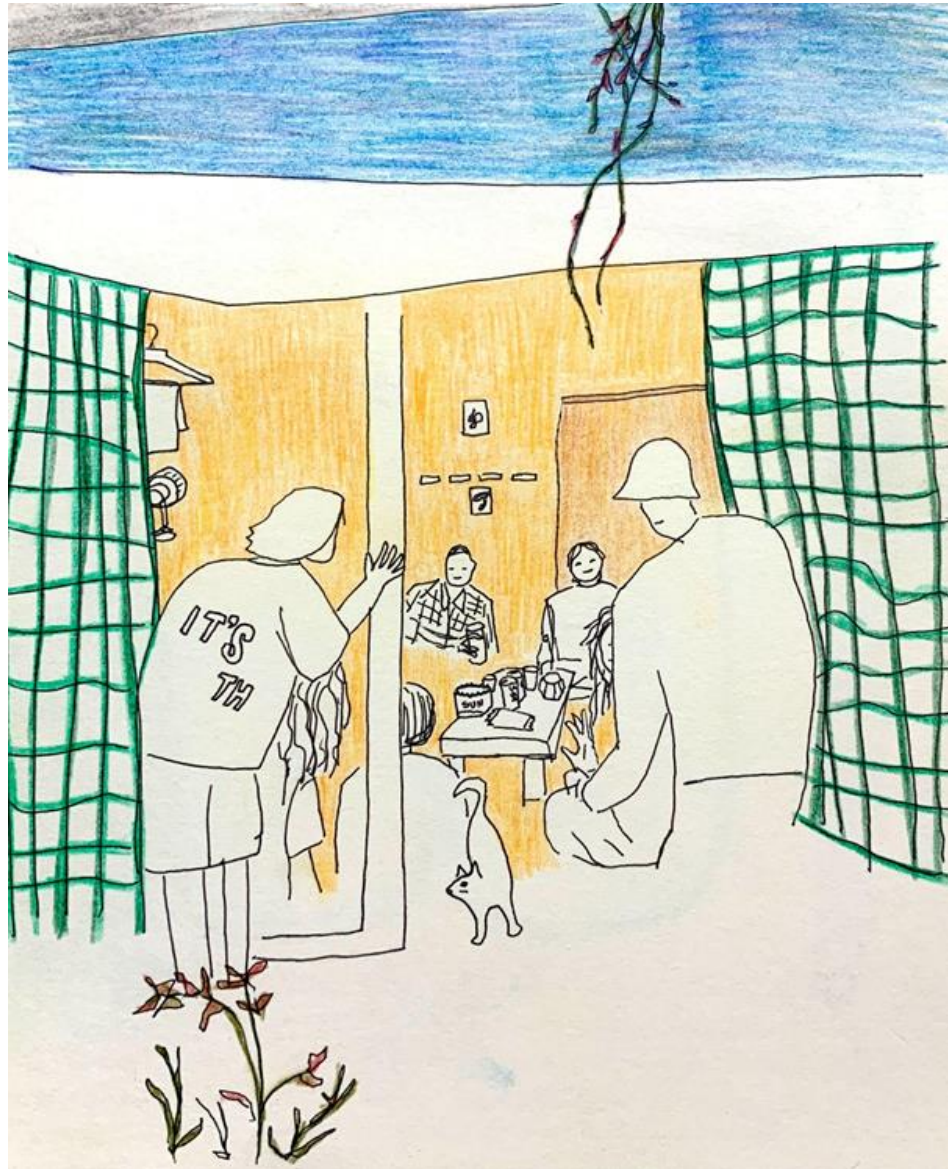
Drawings from an online ethnography class and a discussion of the impact on student experience.

## Introduction

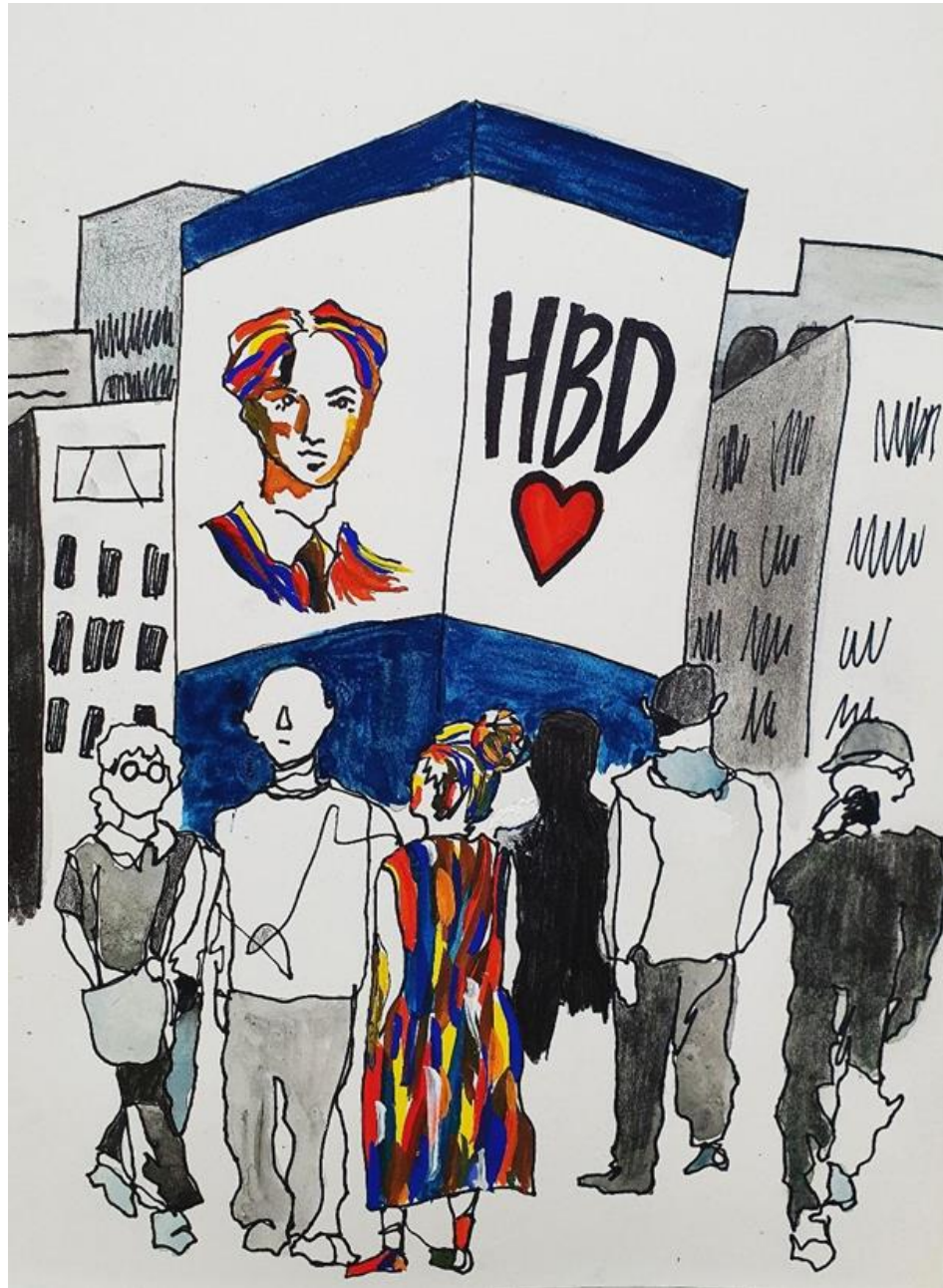
I (Mihye Cho) taught urban ethnography by facilitating remote zoom classes due to the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic. Teaching online-ethnography does not make sense at all. However, I tried. I made students submit neighborhood reports hoping that they would like the idea of walking around their neighborhoods. Soon I sensed that for these young people, being outside itself was therapeutic. I lately convened an informal discussion with students concerning the recurring tragic accidents, including the Sewol ferry disaster, the misogyny-related cases, and the crowd crush in Itaewon. All of them involved many young casualties. The students conveyed a sense of collective trauma and some said that they felt “society” treating them as “insignificant”. When I encouraged students to go out for drawing the city, I just hoped that they would have fun without wearing a mask. Yet they contemplated and drew their social membership and the meaning of worth.
